

## One Point Perspective

**Horizon line** - The imaginary line where the earth meets the sky.

**Vanishing point** - The point on the horizon line where all lines converge.

**Orthogonal** - The lines leading from the object to the vanishing point.

Every line in a one point perspective drawing will be horizontal, vertical or orthogonal.  
All vertical lines are parallel. All horizontal lines are parallel.

1. Draw a horizon line, which is horizontal.
2. Choose a vanishing point.
3. Draw the front face of an object or shape.
4. Connect every corner of the shape to the vanishing point. (some may not be visible)
5. Draw horizontal and vertical lines to show where the shape ends.
6. Erase the remaining part of the orthogonal lines.
